1. Initial Report re Alleged Food Poisoning Incident in San Fernando, Bukidnon (Region X)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 7:00 PM, 06 December 2015, fifty-seven (57) persons sought consultation at Bukidnon Provincial Hospital after partaking in a wedding buffet at around 1:00 PM on the same date

B. Effects:

- Out of the 57 persons affected, twenty-one (21) were admitted while the rest were treated as outpatients

C. Actions Taken:

- DOH X coordinated with the Regional Epidemiology, Surveillance and Disaster Response Unit (RESDRU) and the Regional Health Emergency Management Staff (HEMS) regarding the incident
- DOH X provided Php20,000.00 worth of medicines to the victims
- OCD X continuously coordinating with DOH X for updates

2. Incident Report re Food Poisoning Incident in Damulog, Bukidnon (Region X)

A. Situation Overview:

- On 03 December 2015, a total of 49 individuals from Barangay Sampagar, Damulog, Bukidnon suffered stomach cramps and vomiting after eating spaghetti and fried chicken

- The victims were brought to Bukidnon Provincial Hospital – Kibawe, Ermavi Hospital, Simbulan Sto Niño Hospital, and Don Carlos Hospital for treatment

B. Effects:

- Forty-four (44) persons were admitted due to food poisoning and moderate dehydration and were since discharged while five (5) were treated as outpatients

C. Actions Taken:

- DOH X coordinated with the Regional Epidemiology, Surveillance and Disaster Response Unit (RESDRU), the Sanitary Inspector of Rural Health Unit (RHU) Damulog, and with the Disease Surveillance Officer of Bukidnon Provincial Hospital – Kibawe for verification of the event
 - OCD X continuously coordinating with DOH X for updates.
