I. CHRONOLOGY OF EVENTS

Southwest monsoon started affecting Central and Southern Luzon, and Visayas on 22 September 2013, as Typhoon Odette exited the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR). It brought heavy rains and even floodings in parts of Regions III, IV-A, IV-B and NCR.

On 26-27 September 2013, Tropical Storm "Paolo" (WUTIP) enhanced this weather system and brought rains and thunderstorms over the western sections of Central and Southern Luzon.

II. EFFECTS

A. Incidents Monitored (TAB A)

- **Thirty-five (35)** incidents were monitored in Regions III, IV-A, and IV-B:
 - ✓ **14** Landslides: (Subic, San Marcelino and Castillejos, Zambales; Talisay, Tuy, Cuenca, and 2 in Bauan, all in Batangas; 2 in Ternate, Cavite; Coron and Busuanga, Palawan and Calamba, Laguna)
 - ✓ **2** Storm Surges: (Nasugbu, Batangas; and Magsaysay, Occidental Mindoro)
 - ✓ **3** Flashfloods: (Dinalupihan and Hermosa, Bataan; Olongapo City)
 - ✓ **5** Floodings (Busuanga, Palawan; San Jose and Sablayan, Occidental Mindoro; Oriental Mindoro; and Buenavista, Guimaras)
 - ✓ **4** Tornado: (Magsaysay, Occidental Mindoro; and 3 in Buenavista, Guimaras)
 - ✓ **2** Overflowed Rivers: (Pola River and Salagan River in Sta. Cruz, Occidental Mindoro)
 - ✓ **1** Liquefaction: (Tuy, Batangas)
 - ✓ **1** Missing Fisherman: (Sta Cruz, Occidental Mindoro)

- ✓ 1 Collapsed Wall: (Talisay, Batangas)
- ✓ 1 Soil Erosion: (Talisay, Batangas)
- ✓ 1 Drowning Incident: (Pakil, Laguna)

III. ACTIONS TAKEN

EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE:

A. NATIONAL

1. NDRRMC

- **NDRRMC–OPCEN** maintained its BLUE Alert status
- Disseminated NDRRMC Advisories on Weather Advisory to all regions affected through SMS and facsimile, uploaded the same at the NDRRMC Website, Facebook, and Twitter accounts for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their respective Areas of Responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants
- Accepted the offer of the U.S. Government for response assets, food, and non-food items

2. DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL WELFARE AND DEVELOPMENT (DSWD)

- DSWD prepositioned **₱88.25 Million** worth of emergency relief resources consisting of standby funds (**₱4.87 Million**), **40,489** family food packs (**₱10.02**

Million), other food items (**₱24.63 Million**) and NFIs (**₱48.73 Million**) are readily available for augmentation to any type of disasters in the region:

- DSWD-CO provided ₱2 million to DSWD-FO III for the relief operations for the affected families due to Habagat
- Processed the release of financial assistance to the dead and injured victims of landslides in Subic and Castillejos, Zambales worth **₱350,000.00** (₱10,000.00 for **31** bereaved families and ₱5,000.00 for **8** injured persons)
- SWAD Team staff proceeded to the municipalities of Subic, San Marcelino, Castillejos and Olongapo City to distribute family food packs, non-food items and and provide psychological support to the families
