I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Northeast Monsoon started affecting Northern, Central and Southern Luzon on 18 December 2015.



II. EFFECTS:

A. Pre-Emptive Evacuation

- A total of **1,080 families / 4,792 persons** in the provinces of Laguna, Cavite, Quezon and Bohol were pre-emptively evacuated due to Northeast Monsoon:

III. DISASTER PREPAREDNESS:

A. National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (NDRRMC)

1. National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Operations Center (NDRRMOC)

- a. Maintained Red Alert status at the NDRRM Operations Center on 13-19 December 2015 to continuously monitor and ensure dissemination of Weather Advisories and 24-hour Public Weather Forecasts to all RDRRMCs/OCDRCs through SMS, facsimile, and websites for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal level.

2. Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical, and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA)

- a. Monitored the situation and disseminated Weather Advisories, 24-hour Public Weather Forecast, General Flood Bulletins, and Heavy Rainfall Warnings.

3. Department of Social Welfare and Development (DSWD)

- a. The Local Social Welfare and Development Officers (LSWDOs) provided assistance to the affected families.
- b. Activated Disaster Management Response Team (DMRT), Social Welfare and Development Teams (SWADTs) and Provincial/Municipal Action Teams (P/MATs) to monitor the status of the affected areas and produce reports.
- c. Field Office (FO) made available Family Food Packs (FFPs) for augmentation.

4. Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP) GHQ

- a. OJ3 directed SOLCOM, NOLCOM, Major Services and JTF-NCR to alert their respective HADR assets for possible HADR operations regarding the continuous monsoon in NCR and other adjacent provinces.

B. Regional/Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (R/LDRRMCs)

1. OCD/RDRRMCs IV-A, VII, and NCR

- a. Disseminated weather advisories, general flood bulletins, and heavy rainfall advisory to concerned LDRRMOs through SMS and facsimile and uploaded the same to media accounts to ensure widest dissemination of these advisories, and continuously monitor the weather situation in their AORs and untoward incidents.

2. Office of Civil Defense IV-A (CALABARZON)

- a. Raised its alert status to Red effective 19 December 2015.
- b. Disseminated reminder to Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils re landslide-prone areas.
- c. Deployed RDANA Team to Quezon Province on 21 December 2015.
- d. Coordinated with SOLCOM and 202nd Infantry Bde, 2ID regarding deployment of SRR Teams and the conduct of relief operations in Infanta, Quezon.
- e. Coordinated with DSWD IV-A for the facilitation of relief goods to heavily affected areas.
- f. PDRRMC Quezon OpCen was raised to Red Alert Status and instructed LDRRMOs to inspect and assess landslide-prone areas in their AOR.

3. RDRRMC VII

Office of Civil Defense VII

- a. OCD VII on Red Alert Status and monitored the weather situation within AOR.

DSWD VII

- a. Local Social Welfare and Development Office provided relief items for IDPs in Candijay, Bohol.
