1. Fire Incident in Cebu City, Cebu (Region VII)

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 6:22 PM, 26 December 2015, a fire incident transpired in Barangay Lahug, Cebu City, Cebu involving houses mostly made of light materials.
- The fire was declared out at 12:20 AM, 27 December 2015.
- The affected families are temporarily sheltered at Lahug Elementary School.
- The cause of fire and estimated cost of damages are yet to be determined
- No casualties were reported on the incident

B. Effects:

- A total of 175 families / 679 individuals were affected in the incident
- A total of 74 houses (5 partially, 69 totally) were burned as a result of the incident

C. Actions Taken:

- BFP VII, Emergency Rescue Unit Foundation, PRC-Cebu Chapter, University of San Carlos Fire Brigade, and Barangay Apas Fire Volunteer responded to the incident
- CDRRMO Cebu City conducted assessment on the affected houses and establishments
- CSWDO Cebu City provided food packs and other relief items to the victims
- OCD VII continuously coordinates with Cebu City Fire Station for information and updates on the incident

2. Progress Report re Missing Fishing Boat in Busuanga, Palawan (Region IV-B)

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 11:00 AM, 26 December 2015, a fishing boat with four (4) passengers departed at 7:00 AM, 19 December 2015, was reported missing
- The boat has the following descriptions:
 - Thirty-one (31) footer
 - Painted blue
 - Has a twin engine ("YAMA") with compressor
 - Has no name
- At 6:00 PM, 26 December 2015, the aforesaid boat together with its crew members were found in the vicinity of Busuanga, Palawan and were brought safely to their respective homes

B. Effects:

- The passengers from Barangay Maglambay, Busuanga, Palawan who were reported missing are as follows:
 1. Gerald Bolyes, 29 y/o
 2. Raul Morales, 35 y/o
 3. Peter Paul Acosta, 24 y/o
 4. Roging Baldado, 37 y/o

C. Actions Taken:

- MDRRMC Busuanga coordinated with Philippine Coast Guard (PCG) Talampulan for the conduct of Search, Rescue, and Recovery (SRR) operation
 - OCD IV-B coordinated with MDRRMOs of Culion and Linapacan
 - OCD IV-B coordinated with MDRRMO Busuanga and PCG regarding the incident.
