**1. Progress Report re Fire Incident in Barangay Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City**

**A. Situation Overview:**

- At about 7:19 AM, 22 January 2016, a residential fire occurred in Brgy. Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City
- At about 8:10 AM of the same date, the fire reached Task Force C.
- **At around 9:45 AM, fire was declared out.**
- **The fire originated at the ground floor of a two (2) storey residential house occupied and owned by the Alvarado Family, particularly at the small stockroom for clothes and other materials.**
- The cause of fire is still to be determined

**B. Effects:**

- **Around 300 families were affected. A total of 216 families/841 individuals were evacuated at Jose Fabella Center and were catered by CSWD Mandaluyong.**
- **The estimated cost of damages amounted to ₱ 2,000,000.00**
