





### **1. Progress Report re International Eucharistic Congress (Region VII)**

#### **A. Situation Overview:**

- The International Eucharistic Congress (IEC) is a gathering of people aimed to promote awareness on the central place of the Eucharist in the life and mission of the Catholic Church.
- The 512st IEC is set to take place in Cebu on 24-31 January 2016
- The following are the identified staging areas:
  - Montebello Villa Hotel Parking Area, Cebu City
  - Oakridge Pavilion Parking Area, Mandaue City
  - Cebu Doctors University, Mandaue City
- Catholic Bishops Conference of the Philippines (CBCP) delegates arrived in Cebu City on 19 January 2016
- The Theological Symposium was conducted in Cebu Doctors University on 21 January 2016
- As of 26 January 2016, the IEC Proper is being conducted at the IEC Pavilion, Mabolo, Cebu City. Concurrent sessions were also held at Waterfront Lahug Hotel and Casino, while religious activity was held in Fuente Osmeña Circle, Cebu City. Moreover, IEC delegate toured in Simala, Sibonga and Northern Cebu Towns. Papal Legate visited Cebu Provincial Detention and Rehabilitation Center (CPDRC), Cebu City
- As of 25 January 2016, a total of 220 delegates (129 foreign and 91 local) arrived in Cebu

#### **B. Actions Taken:**

- On 26 January 2016, an operational briefing of RIMT personnel was conducted and the Incident Command Post and Staging Area in Barrio Luz, Cebu City was activated
- DOH was placed on Code White Alert from 19 January to 02 February 2016
- DOH provided logistical support amounting to ₱526,046.40
- OCD VII Coordinated with Cebu Port Authority regarding assets to be deployed during the IEC activities



- Cebu City DRRMO, PNP, BFP, and Federation of Volunteer through Radio Communication Inc. (FVRC), established Task Force Area at IT Park, Lahug, Cebu City
- CCDRMO and FVRC established of Task Force Area at DOH Compound, Fuente Osmeña, Cebu City
- PDRMO, DOH and FVRC established Task Force Area at CPDRC, Cebu City
- On 26 January 2016, PNP CBRNE Team conducted background radiation reading, paneling, and inspection at IEC Pavilion, Cebu City, Cebu Provincial Detention and Rehabilitation Center and Waterfront Hotel, Cebu City

## 2. Initial Report on the Flooding Incident in the Province of Leyte due to Continuous Heavy Rains

### A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 8:00 AM on 27 January 2016, MDRRMO- Dulag, Leyte reported a flooding incident in the aforementioned municipality due to continuous rains since 25 January 2016.
- As of 7:30 AM, suspension of classes was declared in the municipality.
- Some roads and bridges became impassable due to flooding incident.
- Alert Level of Daguitan River Watershed was raised to alert level 2.

#### B. Actions Taken:

- MDRRMC – Dulag
  - Convened the council for possible evacuation measures
- MDRRMC – Javier
  - Prepared for possible evacuation measures
- MDRRMC – Abuyog
  - Deployed an Emergency Response Team
  - Warned the public for possible evacuation measures
  - Declared suspension of classes

- MDRRMC – Dagami
    - Close monitoring of the incident
  - MDRRMC – Hilongos
    - Deployed rescue team to respond to the drowning incident.
  - PDRRMC – Leyte
    - Close monitoring of the watersheds in the province.
    - Close monitoring and coordination between affected LGUs.
  - OCD
    - Closely monitoring the reported flooded incident.
    - Coordinated with PDRRMO – Leyte.
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
