1. Progress Report re Fire Incident at Basakan Pinikitan, Barangay Camamanan, Cagayan de Oro City (Region X)

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 10:01 AM, 14 February 2016, a fire incident transpired in Basakan Pinikitan, Barangay Camaman-an, Cagayan de Oro City involving residential houses.
- At about 1:00 PM of the same day, the fire was declared out.
- · The cause of fire is still undetermined

B. Effects:

- A total of <u>261 families / 1,012 individuals</u> were affected and evacuated at the Barangay Camaman-an covered court (212 families / 797 individuals) and Camaman-an Elementary School (49 families / 215 individuals)
- A total of 150 residential houses were damaged.
- The estimated cost of damages amounted to Php 5,000,000.00
- A total of 36 persons were injured on the incident.

C. Actions Taken:

- 1. BFP Cagayan De Oro City and other respose units immediately responded to the incident and brought the injured victims to Northern Mindanao Medical Center (NMMC).
- 2. CDRRMC Cagayan de Oro through the City Social Welfare Development (CSWD) provided relief assistance to the affected residents.

2. Grenade Explosion Incident in Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat (Region XII)

A. Situation Overview:

 On 21 February 2016, 8:00 PM, a grenade exploded in a Carnival (Peryahan) at the Public Market, Poblacion, Esperanza, Sultan Kudarat

 The incident resulted to the death of a certain Anthon Jhon Antonio, 6 y/o of Barangay Pamantingan, Esperanza and injured 44 individuals:

C. Actions Taken:

- 1. LGU Esperanza SAR team transported the victims to hospitals for treatment.
- Municipal Health Office (MHO) Esperanza personnel and Philippine Red Cross - Sultan Kudarat provided first aid to the victims.
- 3. PNP Esperanza secured the area of incident.
- 4. SOCO team conducted crime scene investigation and identified the explosive used.
- 5. MDRRMC Esperanza conducted emergency meeting regarding the incident on 22 February 2016 .
- 6. OCD XII continuously coordinates with MDRRMO Esperanza for updates on the incident
