1. Final Report re Flooding incident in Camarines Norte (Region V)

A. Situation Overview:

 On 03 March 2016, the municipalities of Daet and Mercedes in Camarines Norte experienced flooding due to continuous light to moderate rains

B. Effects:

- All flooded areas in the Municipalities of Daet and Merceded in Camarines Sur have subsided as of 04 March 2016
- · Classes were suspended in the following municipalities due to flooding:

C. Actions Taken:

- MDRRMC Mercedes issued Advisory No. 1 on 03 March 2016 at 3:00 PM and suspended classes at all levels from 03 - 04 March 2016
- PDRRMO Camarines Norte coordinated with the concerned MDRRMCs re the situation
- OCD V coordinated with PDRRMO Camarines Norte, MDRRMCs Mercedes and Daet re the situation; and disseminated PAGASA weather forecast to LDRRMCs
- · Mercedes DRRMC convened
- MDRRMC Daet conducted damage assessment and need analysis (DANA), suspended classes at all levels until 04 March 2016, activated Joint Operation Center, activated local code 3, deployed personnel at different barangays within the AOR, advice Punong Barangay to activate Barangay Operation Center, and deployed Daet MPS to provide traffic assistance in flooded areas
