1. Fire Incident in Brgy. Botocan, Quezon City (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

 At 8:07 AM, 06 May 2016, a fire incident took place at 1037 Area 7, Brgy. Botocan, Quezon City. The incident reached the 5th alarm before it was put out at 9:13 AM.

B. Effects:

- An estimated 50 houses were affected, with 100 families/500 persons involved.
- Casuaties:
