#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**

The conduct of the National and Local Elections was held on 09 May 2016, as provided by the 1987 Philippine Constitution.

The following positions were filled by the conduct of the simultaneous and fully automated elections, particularly:

- President
- Vice President
- Senators
- House of Representatives
- Governors, Vice Governors and Members of the Provincial Boards for Provinces
- Mayors and Vice Mayors of Cities and Municipalities
- Members of the City Councils and Municipal Councils
- Governor, Vice Governor and all 24 seats in the Regional Assembly of the Autonomous Region in Muslim Mindanao (ARMM)

The Commission on Elections (COMELEC) reported that of the total number of 54.4 million only 40 million, or roughly 81.62% voted.

The Philippine National Police (PNP) identified nine (9) provinces as under the Election Watchlist Areas (EWAs), namely:

- Abra
- Lanao del Norte
- Lanao del Sur
- Maguindanao
- Masbate
- Negros Oriental
- Nueva Ecija
- Pangasinan
- Western Samar

## II. EFFECTS

### A. Incidents Monitored (Tab A)

1. A total of forty (40) incidents were monitored in Regions CAR, II, NCR, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, VI, VIII, IX, X, CARAGA and ARMM.

1. As of 11 May 2016, a total of twenty-three (23) dead and thirty four (34) injured persons were reported in Regions CAR, II, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, VI, VIII, X, CARAGA, and ARMM.

### III. DISASTER PREPAREDNESS

#### A. NATIONAL / NDRRMC

##### 1. NDRRM Operations Center

- a. NDRRM Operations Center was raised to Blue Alert Status, effective at 5:00 PM, 06 May 2016. NDRRMOC disseminated a text message to NDRRMC Member Agencies and RDRRMCs/OCDRCs to that effect. Consequently, representatives from PNP, BFP, and AFP rendered duty at the NDRRMOC as Detailed Duty Officers (DDOs) to ensure continuous coordination.
- b. Coordinated with all Chairpersons, RDRRMCs/OCD Regional Directors to gather reports on preparedness measures and related incidents with various activities and actions taken by their agency and local offices in their respective AORs.

##### 2. Philippine Atmospheric, Geophysical and Astronomical Services Administration (PAGASA)

- a. Continuously provided with Weather Bulletins / Advisories.
- b. Local PAGASA disseminated weather advisories to RDRRMC member agencies.

##### 3. Bureau of Fire Protection (BFP)

- a. All BFP Regional Offices and Fire stations are on heightened alert effective 8:00 AM, 07 May 2016.
- b. Directed all officers and key personnel to be on call and ready to extend assistance in case of emergencies and other eventualities.
- c. Fire trucks of BFP in Regions III, CALABARZON, VI, and CAR performed roving activities within their AOR.
- d. BFP Regions I, III, CALABARZON, and XII conducted visibility and inspection in polling centers.
- e. Personnel deployed in Regions II, CALABARZON, VII, and NCR together with its fire trucks and EMS ambulances are on standby.

##### 4. Department of Education (DepEd)

- a. Issued Department Memorandum No. 65 series of 2016 for the establishment of task force operation center in the central, regional and schools division offices in connection with the 09 May 2016 national and local elections.
- b. Activated Election Task Force operation center nationwide for Public School Teachers with poll duties starting 08 May to 10 May 2016.
- c. Conducted an online seminar for public school teachers with election duties in partnership with COMELEC and RAPPLER.
- d. Prepared Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with COMELEC and Public Attorney's Office (PAO) to give free legal assistance to public school teachers and/or members of Board of Election Inspectors (BEIs) charged with or is under investigation in relation to the performance election duties.

## **5. Department of Health (DOH)**

- a. Issued Department Memorandum to all DOH Regional Offices and DOH Hospitals to raise Code White Alert from 30 April to 15 May 2016.
- b. Maintains continuous monitoring and coordinating with DOH regional offices and attached agencies for any eventuality that may occur during election period.
- c. Prepositioned response teams and medical supplies.
- d. All DOH regional offices are continuously coordinating with provincial, city and municipal health offices and hospitals for medical management of election-related casualties.
- e. Coordinated with PNP regarding provinces with identified election hotspots.
- f. Deployed logistical support which includes personnel, medicines, medical supplies and equipment to health stations in the identified priority voting areas on 09 May 2016.

## **B. REGIONAL / LOCAL DRRM Councils**

1. - c. Sent traffic advisories and safety precautions to the public through the social media account and the InfoBoard platform.
- d. Continuous coordination with PDRRMCs OpCen for weather status, preparedness, actions taken for the observance of Election 2016 and monitored incidents in their respective AORs.
- e. Sent memorandum to the members of Cordillera RDRRMC and LDRRMCs alerted members of the Cordillera RDRRMC Response Clusters.
- f. Continuous information dissemination in partnership with the Cordillera RDRRMC members, PDRRM Offices, PNP, PIA and local media (Tri-media and General Public thru OCD InfoBoard, Social Networking media, SMS and Telephone Calls).
- g. Placed Emergency Communications Kit and single-side band radios on standby.
- h. Generated public advisories about precautionary measures/safety tips during elections in Social Media for public consumption; text brigade on safety tips via InfoBoard.
- i. Prepositioned generator sets for possible deployment.

- a. On Alert Status.

**DPWH-CAR**

- a. On Alert Status and continuously monitors road conditions.
- b. Coordinated with Cordillera RDRRMC Operations Center on current road status.

**DOH-CAR**

- a. Coordinated with RDRRMC regarding reports on monitored incident.

**AFP****Philippine Air Force (TOG 1, 1AD, PAF)**

- a. On heightened alert.
- b. Prepositioned SAR equipment.
- c. Placed 20 personnel on standby for 2016 Election.

- e. Informed all RDRRMC I member agencies and PDRRMCs to include the four governors to undertake preparedness measures and activate their respective operations centers.
- f. Conducted RDRRMC 1 Special Meeting re National and Local Elections 2016 on 06 May 2016, 9:30 AM in San Fernando, La Union presided by Dir. Melchito Castro. The said meeting was attended by COMELEC, DILG, DSWD, DOH, NGCP, DOST-PAGASA, PNP, BFP, AFP, PCG and PDRRMOs of La Union and Pangasinan. The meeting focused on the preparedness measures of member agencies, especially in areas identified as election watchlist areas.
- g. Lifted the Alert Status effective 11 May 2015, 5:00 PM.

- a. Activated operations center effective 07 May 2016.
- b. Closely monitoring areas under election watch list areas.

**DSWD FO I**

- a. Activated Social Welfare Development Action Team to respond to any untoward incident and other emergency concerns.
- b. Prepositioned relief goods including bottled water on DSWD warehouses within the region.
- c. Provided assistance to distressed indigent passengers with no fare going to their hometowns through the "Balik Probinsya Assistance" program.
- d. Coordinated with LSWDOs and COMELEC to provide Women and Child-friendly spaces and to report any case of gender-sensitive violence.

**COMELEC I**

- a. Conducted final testing and sealing of vote counting machines in the region to avoid malfunction during election.
- b. Coordinated with different government agencies particularly PNP, AFP and DOH to ensure a peaceful, safe, and secure election.

- j. Three (3) DOH retained hospitals (Ilocos Training and Regional Medical Center, Regional 1 Medical Center and Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital and Medical Center) are on 24 hours duty.
- k. Attended special meeting for the May 2016 Election Preparedness Measures on 06 May 2016.
- l. The four (4) Provincial Operations Centers are in direct coordination with LDRRMCs and local units for needed assistance.

- d. Created Regional Personnel Orders and Advisory to identify tasks of the persons to be deployed during election.

- b. Installed legible informational and directional signs on conspicuous locations along national roads.

- a. Instructed Coast Guard personnel who render duty in the ports to implement inspection of baggage and implementation of security layers in ports and passenger terminals.
- b. Placed all Coast Guard detachments in the region on standby alert and tasked operatives to man the help desk in the ports.
