I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

A. Chronology and Tropical Cyclone Tracks

17 January 2014

• The Low Pressure Area (LPA) in Southeast of Guiuan. Eastern Samar had developed into a Tropical Depression and was named "Agaton" with maximum sustaining winds of 55 kph near the center. Tropical Depression "AGATON" maintained its strength as it continued to move towards the Surigao Provinces



18 January 2014

 TD "AGATON" maintained its strength as it continued to move west slowly. At 4:00 PM, TD "AGATON" moved southeastward while maintaining its strength

19 January 2014

 TD "AGATON" moved southwestward while maintaining its strength. At 10:00 AM, it slightly accelerated at 205 km Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur or 230 km East of Davao City. At 4:00 PM, it slowed down while maintaining its strength

20 January 2014

 At 4:00 AM, TD "AGATON" moved east southeast slowly while maintaining its strength. At 10:00 AM, it weakened into a Low Pressure Area at 400 km East Southeast of Davao City or 455 km East of General Santos City

B. Tropical Cyclone Analysis

"AGATON" was first Tropical Cyclone that affected the country. It was a low pressure area and developed into a Tropical Depression 130 km northeast of Guiuan, Easter Samar in the morning of 17 January 2014 and Public Storm Warning Signal no. 01 was hoisted over Eastern Mindanao. It then moved westward slowly at 5 kph.

In the morning 18 January 2014, "AGATON" continued moving in the same direction and speed closer to Surigao Provinces. It then moved back to the southeast while maintaining its Tropical Depression intensity in the afternoon of the same day. It again changed direction to the south southwest at slowly 5 kph in the morning of 19 January 2014. It continued moving in the same direction and speed in the evening of the same day. "AGATON" weakened into a Low Pressure Area in the morning of 20 January 2014.

TD "AGATON" stayed inside PAR for four (4) days from 17-20 January 2014 and reached maximum sustained winds of 55 kph near the center.

II. EFFECTS

A. INCIDENTS MONITORED (TAB A)

- 1. A total of <u>twenty-four (24) incidents</u> were monitored in Regions VIII, IX, X, XI, CARAGA and ARMM due to TD "AGATON":
 - a. Sixteen (16) landslide incidents in Southern Leyte, Zamboanga City, Lanao del Norte, Lanao del Sur, Davao del Norte, Davao Oriental, Agusan del Norte, Agusan del Sur, Surigao del Sur, and Dinagat Islands
 - b. Six (6) floodings/flashflood incidents in Camiguin, Davao del Norte, Compostela Valley, Agusan del Sur, Surigao del Norte, and Maguindanao
 - c. Two (2) maritime incidents in Cebu and Leyte

B. CASUALTIES (TAB B)

1. There were <u>one hundred sixty five (165) casualties:</u> 70 were dead, 86 were injured, and 9 are still missing in Regions IX, X, XI, and CARAGA:

C. AFFECTED POPULATION (TAB C)

1. A total of <u>236,449 families or 1,092,398 persons</u> were affected in <u>985</u> barangays in <u>128 municipalities</u> and <u>11 cities</u> in <u>16 provinces</u> of Regions X, XI, XII, CARAGA and ARMM.

D. DAMAGED HOUSES (TAB D)

1. Number of damaged houses: <u>4,301 houses</u> (1,704 totally/2,327 partially) in Regions V, X, XI, and CARAGA.

E. ROADS AND BRIDGES (TAB E)

1. A total of **72 roads and 34 bridges** were rendered not passable due to flooding, landslide, and mudslide in Regions VIII, IX, X, XI, and CARAGA.

F. STATUS OF STRANDEES

1. The number of streandess peaked at 9,956 passengers, 18 vessels, 8 motorbancas, and 723 rolling cargoes in various Coast Guard Stations in Cebu, Catbalogan, Camarines Sur, Sorsogon, and Masbate.

G. STATUS OF MAJOR RIVERS AND DAMS

- Saug River in the municipality of Asuncion and Libungan River in the municipality in Kapalong both in the province of Davao del Norte overflowed due to continuous heavy rains.
- Irrigation Dams in Aragon and Brgy. Taytayan in Cateel, Davao Oriental were damaged due to flooding.

H. COST OF ASSISTANCE (TAB F)

<u>PhP98,694,400.81</u> worth of relief goods were provided to the affected families from the combined resources of DSWD (PhP56,838,997.21), LGUs (PhP37,307,174.55), NGOs/Other GOs (PhP2,250,027.00) and DOH (PhP2,103,164.05) in Regions V, X, XI, XII and CARAGA.

III. EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT

NDRRMC Operations Center

- NDRRMOC remained under **BLUE ALERT STATUS**
- Disseminated NDRRMC Advisories on Weather Advisory to all regions affected through SMS and facsimile, uploaded the same at the NDRRMC Website, Facebook, and Twitter accounts for further dissemination to their respective local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels

PAGASA

• Disseminated Weather Bulletins and advisories and constantly monitors the situation

AFP

- PS20 vessel from Naval Forces Eastern Military conducted relief operations to affected areas
- Two (2) UH-1H HELIS from TOG 11 conducted SAR operations in 701 Bde Hqs.

- Troops of 75IB with PNP provided manpower assistance to the evacuees of Brgy. San Gabriel and Binongan in Veruela, Agusan del Sur and two (2) squads of Alpha Coy, 75IB provided manpower assistance to the evacuees of Brgy. Tapaz and Brgy. Poblacion, Sta. Josefa, Agusan del Sur
- One (1) section of 75IB with one (1) M35 truck provided manpower assistance to the evacuees of Brgy. Tabon, Bislig City, Surigao del Sur

- PNP Butuan City assisted in the packing and distribution of relief goods, mass feeding and security in evacuation centers.

 Prepositioned Php47.87 million worth of emergency relief resources consisting of standby funds (P P5.79 million), 61,982 family food packs (P16.53 million) and other food and NFIs (P26.6 million) readily available for augmentation.

PRC

- Deployed personnel to conduct monitoring and to augment in relief distribution in affected areas in Compostela Valley, Lanao del Norte, Agusan del Sur, Davao del Norte, Agusan del Norte, Davao Oriental and Surigao del Norte
- Assessment was conducted in the Municipality of Jabonga, Agusan del Norte where evacuees already stayed for about 4 days in the evacuation center and rising of evacuated families was being reported

- Surigao del Sur and Agusan del Sur are closely monitoring flood prone areas in their respective areas of resposibility; all other LDRRMCs are on heightened alert status
- Surigao del Norte conducted coordination meeting with MDRRMC Tubod and Mainit; prepositioned 100 food packs for each municipality; PDRRMO zone teams were also dispatched to inspect and evaluate situation in highrisk areas; prepositioned vehicles and conducted pre-emptive evacuation; and conducted relief operations

- Agusan del Norte conducted ocular survey in flood and landslide-prone barangays of Cabadbaran, Tubay, Jabonga and RTR; Agusan del Norte Emergency Response Team (ADNERT) assisted the Butuan City Search and Rescue in the conduct of rescue operations to Brgys.
