I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

The Low Pressure Area (LPA) over the Marianas islands has developed into a Tropical Depression. It is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility by Tuesday (July 5) and will be named "Butchoy".

Location of Center: (as of 8:00 PM)	2,075 km east of Mindanao
Coordinates:	8.3°N, 145.2°E
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of 45 kph near the center
Movement:	Forecast to move Northwest at 10 kph
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	<i>Sunday evening:</i> 1,885 km east of Mindanao <i>Monday evening :</i> 1,655 km east of Southern Luzon <i>Tuesday evening :</i> 1,215 km east of Casiguran, Aurora <i>Wednesday evening :</i> 575 km east of Basco, Batanes <i>Thursday evening :</i> 405 km north of Basco, Batanes

- The general public and disaster risk reduction and management councils concerned are advised to monitor for the next update to be incorporated in the public weather forecast at 5:00 am tomorrow and for the next advisory to be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- **NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 01 re Tropical Depression** to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their

respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels

- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants
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
