#### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

"NEPARTAK" has intensified into a typhoon and is expected to enter the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) this afternoon and will be named "Butchoy".

<b>Location of Center: (as of 10:00 AM)</b>	1,570 km East of Baler, Aurora
<b>Coordinates:</b>	15.6°N, 136.2°E
<b>Strength:</b>	Maximum sustained winds of 120 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 150 kph
<b>Movement:</b>	Forecast to move Northwest at 30 kph
<b>Forecast Positions/Outlook:</b>	<i>24-hour (Tomorrow morning):</i> <b>1,010 km East of Aparri, Cagayan</b> <i>48-hour (Thursday morning) :</i> <b>495 km East Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes</b> <i>72-hour (Friday morning) :</i> <b>435 km North Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes</b> <i>96-hour (Saturday morning) :</i> <b>775 km North of Itbayat, Batanes (outside PAR)</b>

- The general public and disaster risk reduction and management councils concerned are advised to monitor for the next update to be incorporated in the public weather forecast at 5:00 am tomorrow and for the next advisory to be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.

## II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- **NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 01 re Tropical Depression** to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
  - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants
