### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

• At 11:00 AM, 17 July 2016, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 940 km east northeast of Aparri, Cagayan (19.5°N, 130.5°E). This weather disturbance has no direct effect to any part of the country, but its development into a tropical depression is still possible.

#### II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRMC Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 03 for Low Pressure Area (LPA)** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
