I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- The Low Pressure Area (LPA) over the West Philippine Sea and outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) has developed into a Tropical Depression.
- As of 10:00 AM today, the Tropical Depression was estimated 845 KM West of Laoag City, Ilocos Norte (18.1° N, 112.6° E), with maximum winds of 45 KPH. It is moving West Northwest at 20 KPH.
- This weather system has no effect to any part of the country. With this development, this is the final advisory.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRMC Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 03 for Tropical Depression to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
