I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- **The Low Pressure Area (LPA) over the West Philippine Sea and outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR) has developed into a Tropical Depression.**
- **As of 10:00 AM today, the Tropical Depression was estimated 845 KM West of Laoag City, Ilocos Norte (18.1° N, 112.6° E), with maximum winds of 45 KPH. It is moving West Northwest at 20 KPH.**
- **This weather system has no effect to any part of the country. With this development, this is the final advisory.**

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRMC Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 03 for Tropical Depression** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
