I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- At 10:00 AM, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 575 KM east of Guiuan, Eastern Samar (10.9° N, 131.0° E).
- This weather system is embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) that will bring cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over Eastern Visayas and Caraga which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRMC Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 01 for Low Pressure Area** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
