### I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

- At 10:00 AM, the LPA was estimated based on all available data at 1,200 km East of Aparri, Cagayan (19.2°N, 133°E). This LPA will continue to enhance the Southwest Monsoon which will bring moderate to heavy rains over Metro Manila, Ilocos Region, CALABARZON, and the Provinces of Zambales, Bataan, Mindoro, and Northern Palawan. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.
- Meanwhile, light to moderate rains will prevail over Western Visayas and the rest of Luzon.

#### II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRMC Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 02 for LPA and Southwest Monsoon to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
