I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

THE LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) NORTHEAST OF ITBAYAT, BATANES HAS DEVELOPED INTO A TROPICAL DEPRESSION AND WAS NAMED "ENTENG".

Location of Center: (as of 08:00AM)	695 km East Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (23.8°N, 127.7°E)
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 55 kph near the center
Movement:	Forecast to move Northeast at 18 kph .
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	24 Hour(Tomorrow morning): 1,090 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) 48 Hour (Saturday morning): 1,250 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)

- The public and the disaster risk reduction and management council concerned are advised to take appropriate actions and watch for the next weather bulletin to be issued at 11:00AM today.

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- **NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 01 re Tropical Depression “ENTENG”** to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
