#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

**“ENTENG” HAS INTENSIFIED INTO A TROPICAL STORM AS IT CONTINUED TO MOVE IN A NORTHEAST DIRECTION.**

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the <b>250 km diameter</b> of the Tropical Storm.</li><li>The Southwest monsoon enhanced by TS “ENTENG” is expected to bring moderate to occasionally heavy rains over Pangasinan, La Union, and Benguet which may trigger flashfloods and landslides.</li></ul>	
<b>Location of Center: (as of 11:00AM)</b>	730 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (24.0°N, 128.0°E)
<b>Strength:</b>	Maximum sustained winds of up to <b>65 kph</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>80 kph</b> .
<b>Movement:</b>	Forecast to move <b>Northeast</b> at <b>19 kph</b> .
<b>Forecast Positions/Outlook:</b>	<b>24 Hour(Tomorrow morning):</b> 1,120 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) <b>48 Hour (Saturday morning):</b> 1,275 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) <b>72 Hour (Sunday morning):</b> 1,415 km North Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)

## II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- **NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 02 re Tropical Storm “ENTENG”** to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
  - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
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
