I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "ENTENG" IS NOW OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR).

 Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 300 km diameter of the Severe Tropical Storm. 	
Location of Center: (as of 10:00 PM)	1,000 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) (25.2°N, 130.3°E)
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 100 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 130 kph.
Movement:	Forecast to move North Northeast at 19 kph.
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	24 Hour(Tomorrow evening): 1,260 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) 48 Hour (Saturday evening): 1,420 km Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR) 72 Hour (Sunday evening): 1,735 km North Northeast of Itbayat, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 03 (FINAL) re Severe Tropical Storm "ENTENG" to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
