I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM, the LPA was estimated based on all available data at 360 KM east of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.4°N, 129.6°E). This weather disturbance will bring cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains over CARAGA and Northern Mindanao which may trigger flashfloods and landslides. Light to moderate rains and thunderstorms is expected over Southern Leyte, Bohol, and Cebu.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 01 for Low Pressure Area (LPA) to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
