I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

TYPHOON "GENER" IS NOW OUTSIDE THE PHILIPPINE AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY (PAR).

Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy rains within the 450 km diameter of the Typhoon.	
Location of Eye/Center: (as of 4:00 PM)	555 km North of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)(25.4°N, 122.6°E)
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 175 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 210 kph.
Movement	Forecast to move North at 15 kph
	24 Hour (Tomorrow afternoon): 890 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)
Forecast Positions/Outlook:	48 Hour (Monday afternoon): 1,140 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)
	72 Hour (Tuesday afternoon): 1,555 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 13 re
 Typhoon "GENER" (I.N. MALAKAS) to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS
 and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to
 their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils
 (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
