1. Belated Report re : Fire Incident in Looc, Romblon

A. Situation Overview:

- On or about 12:30NN of September 12, 2016, fire incident transpired in Looc Public Market, Romblon (Dry Goods and Grocery Stall Block). Duty personnel of BFP Looc, Romblon and available fire truck immediately responded to the fire scene. Origin and cause of fire are still under investigation.

B. Effects:

- The cost of damage was estimated more or less Php2,000,000.00
- No casualties reported.

C. Actions Taken:

- OCD MIMAROPA coordinated with MDRRMO Looc, Romblon and BFP MIMAROPA regarding the incident.

2. Initial Report re : Missing Fishermen in Magdiwang, Romblon

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 5:00PM, 13 September 2016, two (2) fishermen named Teofilo Damos, 21 years old and Jumar De Juan, 19 years old, both residents of Magdiwang, Romblon were reported missing. The said fishermen departed Magdiwang on or about 6:00AM of 12 September 2016 to conduct fishing venture at vicinity waters of Sibuyan Sea and were expected to return home by late afternoon, but failed to come and had not established contact as of this report.

B. Actions Taken:

- Bantay Dagat and Coast Guard District Southern Tagalog had been notified to extend assistance for possible search and rescue operations.
 - MDRRMO advised all nearby municipalities and local populace transiting the area to be on the look out of the said motor banca and two (2) fishermen onboard.
 - Coordinated with MDRRMO Magdiwang, Romblon, PCG Southern tagalog and CG Station Masbate and Quezon.
