Incident Report re Mt. Bulusan Phreatic Explosion (Region V)

A. Situation Overview:

- On September 16, 2016 (Friday) at 4:54 PM, Bulusan Volcano generated a steamdriven explosion accompanied by a rumbling sound which lasted for approximately 4 minutes based on seismic record;
- It produced approximately 1500 meter-high dark gray ash plume that drifted towards the Northeast;
- Ash fall was reported in the municipalities of Casiguran, Gubat and Barcelona

B. Effects:

- In the past 24 hours, Mt. Bulusan Volcano's seismic monitoring network recorded six (6) volcanic earthquakes including the explosion-type earthquake yesterday;
- Steaming activity could not be observed due to thick clouds covering the summit;
- On 16-25 August 2016, precise levelling data indicated slight inflationary changes of the edifice relative to May 2016;
- Ground deformation data from the continuous GPS measurements as of 3 September 2016, showed inflationary trends since July 2016;
- Alert level 1 (abnormal) remains in effect over Mt. Bulusan Volcano
- Below table are the areas that experienced ash fall based on the ocular inspection made by PDRRMO Sorsogon

C. Actions Taken:

- Coordinated with the PDRRMO-Sorsogon thru SMS status of volcanic activity of Mt. Bulusan;.
- Coordination with PHIVOLCS, Sorsogon PDRRMO, MDRRMO Casiguran, MDRRMO Barcelona, MDRRMO Gubat re: actions taken, preparation and monitoring status of Mt. Bulusan;

PDRRMC Sorsogon

- Informed and coordinated with the six (6) MDRRMOs to conduct immediate assessment within their respective AOR;
- Close coordination with PDRRMC Chairman and Members for the updates regarding the event and possible response actions;
- Coordination with PHIVOLCS from time to time as to the status of Mt. Bulusan Volcano;
- Sent updates for public information via SMS and using their website www.sorsogonpdrrmo.com through social media to all stakeholders;
- Distributed PPE's and NFI's to the affected communities;
- Continuously monitors the condition of Mt. Bulusan Volcano and implements the BLUE ALERT status.
