1. Progress/Final Report re Landslide Incurred by Blasting (Road Widening) at Sitio Damay, Brgy. San Vicente, Sumilao, Bukidnon

A. Situation Overview:

 At around 5:30 PM on September 17, 2016, a landslide induced by blasting occured in the National Highway along Bukidnon-Davao Route, Sitio Damay, Brgy. San Vicente, Sumilao, Bukidnon.

B. Effects:

- Debris covered an estimated 80 meters length/portion of the National Highway
- Damage portion of the Bukidnon-Davao Route (National Highway) is not passable to any vehicles of this report.
- Vehicles coming from and going to Davao are temporarily stranded due to traffic obstruction in the affected area
- No report of casualty.

C. Actions Taken:

- Ongoing cleaning operations by the DPWH 1st District Engineering Office.
- Engr. Virgie nayve, Chief Construction Division immediately instructed the contractor Equiparco to clear the road pavement of slides using their equipment which are on stabdvy at the project site.
