## I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

TYPHOON "HELEN" HAS MAINTAINED ITS COURSE AND IS HEADING TOWARDS BATANES-TAIWAN AREA.

Location of Eye/Center	At 10:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "HELEN" was located based on all available data at 754 km of East of Basco, Batanes (20.3°N, 129.1°E)

#### II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 06 for Typhoon "HELEN" to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
