1. Progress Report regarding Caffeine Overdose Incident in Cebu City (Region VII)

A. Situation Overview:

- At around 2:10 PM, 28 September 2016, after consumption of free bottled coffee drinks (promotional sample), a total of 34 students of Concord Technical Institute in Basak, San Nicolas, Cebu City experienced vomiting, palpitation, and abdominal pain.
- The 34 students were rushed to Cebu City Medical Center for treatment. The students were discharged after clinical management was given.

B. Actions Taken:

- OCD VII coordinated with Department of Health (DOH VII), CDRRMO Cebu City, and Cebu City Medical center for updates on the incident.
- Cebu Cith Health Department and Regional Epidemiology and Surveillance Unit (RESU) of DOH conducted investigation at Cebu City Medical Center and Concord Technical Institute.
- RESU sent samples of the bottled coffee drink to the Food and Drugs Administration (FDA) laboratory for analysis.
- CDRRMO Cebu City sent samples of the bottled coffee drink to Department of Science and Technology (DOST) for laboratory examination.
- Cebu City Emergency Medical Service responded and brought the victims to Cebu City Medical Center.
- RDRRMC VII closely monitors the incident.
