1. Ground Movement in Barangay Parasanon, Pinabacdao, Samar (Region VIII)

A. Situation Overview:

- A critical ground movement was detected by PHIVOLCS Development and Deployment of Early Warning System for Deep-Seated Catastrophic Landslides (DEWS-L) at 7:05 AM, 27 September 2016, in Barangay Parasanon, Pinabacdao, Samar, subsequently, they issued an advisory raising Alert Level 3 (critical ground movement observed in the last 48 hours, landslide may be imminent) in the said barangay. It was recommended that residents at risk in the section of Maharlika Highway be evacuated.
- On 28 September 2016, MDRRMO Pinabacdao conducted an emergency meeting with the concerned barangay and conducted ground assessment. Approximately 30 families were evacuated, of which, four (4) families were evacuated in the Barangay Hall while the others opted to stay with their relatives.
- On 29 September 2016, 2:45 PM, the Technical Working Group of RDRRMC VIII together with the Municipal Mayor of Pinabacdao, Samar convened to discuss the incident.
- To date, three (3) cracks are still being monitored by PHIVOLCS DEWS-L and A3 alert level still persist in Barangay Parasanon, Pinabacdao, Samar. Residents are still advised to be evacuated.

B. Actions Taken:

- OCD VIII coordinated with PHIVOLCS, MGB Regional Office VIII, PDRRMO-Samar, and MDRRMO-Pinabacdao for further assessment and updates on the said ground movement.
- OCD VIII conducted an Emergency Meeting relative to the detected the ground movement and convened the RDRRMC VIII TWG members on 29 September 2016
- PDRRMO Samar closely coordinated with DPWH, OCD VIII, and Provincial Engineering Office for updates and possible deployment of assessment team.

- MDRRMO Pinabacdao conducted an emergency meeting together with Barangay Parasanon Officials.
- MDRRMO Pinabacdao conducted ground assessment and ocular inspection in Barangay Parasanon.
- MDRRMO Pinabacdao prepared food packs for the evacuees.
- MDRRMO Pinabacdao placed signages to alert motorists regarding the situation in the area.
- OCD VIII, PDRRMO Samar, and MDRRMO Pinabacdao closely monitors the incident.

2. Collapsed Improvised Bridge at Balete Pumping Station in Manila (NCR)

A. Situation Overview:

 At about 10:00 AM, 01 October 2016, while barangay personnel were conducting clean-up drive operations, an improvised bridge in Metro Manila Development Authority (MMDA) Balete Pumping Station, Ermita, Manila collapsed.

B. Effects:

• The incident caused the death of one (1) barangay personnel and injury to seven (7):

C. Actions Taken:

- Manila Rescue responded to the incident.
- OCD-NCR coordinated with Manila DRRMO, Manila Police District, and other concerned agencies for updates.

3. Chikungunya Outbreak in Indang, Cavite (CALABARZON)

A. Situation Overview:

• From January to September 24, 2016, an increasing number of Chikungunya cases were reported in eight (8) barangays in Indang, Cavite.

B. Effects:

 A total of 470 diagnosed cases were reported in Barangays Agusos, Guyam Malaki, Guyam Munti, Calumpang Cerca, Poblacion 3, Kaytambug, Dainewan, and Bulalehos 2:

 The number of cases are patients admitted in different hospitals in Indang, Dasmariñas City, and Tagaytay City alone.

C. Actions Taken:

- OCD CALABARZON continuously monitors the situation and closely coordinates with RDRRMC member agencies, DOH IV-A, PDRRMO Cavite, and LGU of Indang for updates and appropriate actions.
- DOH IV-A conducts the following: active surveillance, meeting with barangay officials regarding search and destry activities through larva survey, community assembly for lecture regarding chikungunya, larva survey and clean-up drive, and blood sample collection.
- PDRRMC Cavite provided insect repellant to the Municipality of Indang.
- The Provincial Health Officer of Cavite, Indang Health Officer, and Indang local officials conducted a meeting at Indang Municipal Hall to discuss the increasing cases of chikungunya and the appropriate actions to be undertaken.
- LGU Indang conducted an emergency meeting attended by MDRRMC member agencies, Liga ng mga Barangay, NGOs, and other stakeholders on 03 October 2016 to address the concerns regarding the outbreak.
- LGU Indang conducted clean-up and inspection (spraying, misting, and other preventive measures) on affected areas.
- LGU Indang conducted information and education campaign within the community to increase awareness on chikungunya.
