I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Tropical Storm "JULIAN" is now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

<ul style="list-style-type: none">Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy within the 300 km diameter of the tropical stormSmall sea crafts are advised not to venture out over the northern seaboard of Northern Luzon	
Location of Center: (as of 4:00 PM)	375 km west of Basco, Batanes (outside PAR) (20.8°N, 118.4°E)
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 65 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 100 kph
Movement:	Forecast to move West at 25 kph
Forecast Positions / Outlook:	24 Hour(Tomorrow afternoon): 815 km West of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)
NO TROPICAL CYCLONE WARNING SIGNAL

II. ACTION/S TAKEN

- **NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 12 (FINAL) re Tropical Storm “JULIAN”** to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
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
