I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

Tropical Depression "JULIAN" has maintained its strength as it moves toward the extreme Northern Luzon.

 Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to occasionally heavy within 300 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 02 re
 Tropical Depression "JULIAN" to all OCD Regional Centers through SMS and
 facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to
 their respective local disaster risk reduction and management councils
 (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Centers to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying and mountainous areas if situation warrants.
