I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM, the Low Pressure Area was estimated based on all available data at **715 km east of Catarman, Northern Samar (12.4°N, 131.2°E)**. This weather system will bring cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains and **isolated thunderstorms** over **Eastern Visayas and CARAGA**. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.

This LPA is expected to develop into a Tropical Depression within 24 and will be named "KAREN".

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 02 for Low Pressure Area (LPA)** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
