I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

The Low Pressure Area East of Samar has developed into a tropical depression and was named "KAREN".

Location of Eye/Center	At 4:00AM today, the center of Tropical Depression "KAREN" was estimated based on all available data at 640 km of East of Catarman, Northern Samar (12.6°N, 130.5°E)
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 45 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 55kph
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move West Northwest at 11 kph
Forecast Positions	 24 Hour (Tomorrow morning): 575 km East of Virac, Catanduanes 48 Hour (Saturday morning): 345 km East Northeast of Virac, Catanduanes 72 Hour (Sunday morning): 385 km East of Baler Aurora 96 Hour (Monday morning): 55 km South Southeast of Sinait, Ilocos Sur 120 hour (Tuesday morning): 365 km West of Sinait, Ilocos Sur (Outside PAR)

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 01 for Severe
 Tropical Depression "KAREN" to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile
 and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local
 disaster risk reduction and management councils (DRRMCs) from the provincial down to
 the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
