## I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

TYPHOON "LAWIN" is now outside the Philippine Area of Responsibility (PAR).

<ul> <li>All Tropical</li> </ul>	Cyclone Warning Signal (TCWS) are now lifted
Location of Eye/Center	At 09:00 PM today, the eye of Typhoon "LAWIN" was located based on all available data at 390 km West Northwest of Laoa; City, Ilocos Norte (OUTSIDE PAR) (19.8°N, 117.3°E)
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 120 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 150 kph
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move North Northwest at 19 kph
Forecast Positions	<ul> <li>24 Hour( Tomorrow evening): 815 km West Northwest of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)(24.0°N, 115.1°E)</li> <li>48 Hour(Saturday evening): 965 km North Northwest of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)(28.5°N, 118.5°E)</li> <li>72 Hour(Sunday evening): 1,200 km North Northeast of Basco, Batanes (OUTSIDE PAR)(30.2°N, 127.0°E)</li> </ul>

With this development and unless re-entry occurs, this is the final warning for this weather disturbance.

## II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Severe Weather Bulletin No. 19 (FINAL) for Typhoon "LAWIN" to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
