I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

TD "MARCE" has made landfall over Siargao Island, Surigao del Norte.

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 300 km diameter of the tropical depression.
- Residents of areas under TCWS No. 1, the rest of Eastern Visayas **and the rest of Bicol region** are advised to be alert against possible flashfloods and landslides.
- Sea travel is risky over the seaboards of Northern Luzon
- Expected to exit PAR by Monday morning (28 November 2016)
- **MARCE has made landfall over Siargao Island, Surigao del Norte at around 5:00 PM today.**

Location of Eye/Center	At 7:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression "MARCE" was estimated based on all available data at 75 km North Northwest of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (10.4°N, 125.3°E)
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 55 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 95 kph
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move Northwest at 19 kph

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 10 for Tropical Depression "MARCE"** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
