I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

TS "MARCE" HAS MAINTAINED ITS STRENGTH AS IT MOVES AWAY FROM THE COUNTRY.

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 400 km diameter of the tropical storm.
- Sea travel is risky over the **Northern seaboards** of Northern Luzon.
- Expected to exit the PAR by tomorrow morning or afternoon (27 November 2016)

Location of Eye/Center	At 10:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Storm "MARCE" was estimated based on all available data at 380 km West of Iba, Zambales (14.9°N, 116.5°E)
Strength	Maximum sustained winds of up to 85 kph near the center and gustiness of up to 105 kph
Forecast Movement	Forecast to move Northwest at 15 kph
Forecast Positions	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• 24 Hour (Tomorrow evening): 490 km North of Pagasa Island, Palawan (OUTSIDE) (15.4°N, 114.1°E)• 48 Hour (Monday evening): 395 km North Northwest of Pagasa Island, Palawan (OUTSIDE PAR) (14.2°N, 112.6°E)• 72 Hour (Tuesday evening): 380 km Northwest of Pagasa Island, Palawan (OUTSIDE PAR) (13.0°N, 111.3°E)

NO TROPICAL CYCLONE WARNING SIGNAL

The public and the Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council concerned are advised to take appropriate actions and watch for the next weather bulletin to be issued at 11 AM tomorrow.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 23 for Tropical Storm "MARCE" (I.N. TOKAGE)** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
 - Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
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
