I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated at 430 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (8.0°N, 130.2°E). This weather system will bring cloudy skies and moderate to occasionally heavy rains and isolated thunderstorms over the Regions of Caraga, Davao and SOCCSKSARGEN. Residents in these areas are adviced to be alert against possible flashfloods and landslides. The rest of Mindanao will be cloudy with light to moderate rainshowers and thunderstorms.

The disturbance may develop into a Tropical Cyclone within the next 24 to 48 hours.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 01 for Low Pressure Area to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
