I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area was estimated based on all available data in the vicinity of **San Juan**, **Batangas** (13.6°N, 121.5°E). This will bring cloudy skies with moderate to occasionally heavy rains and thunderstorms over **CALABARZON**. Residents in these areas are alerted against possible flashfloods and landslides.

Meanwhile, light to moderate rains and thunderstorms will be experienced over Metro Manila, Central Luzon, Bicol Region and the Provinces of **Mindoro**, Marinduque, **Romblon**, **Northern Palawan**, Cagayan and Isabela.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated Weather Advisory No. 02 for Low Pressure Area to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
