1. Initial Report re Flashflood Incident in M'lang, Cotabato Province (Region XII)

A. Situation Overview:

 Around 12:30 AM, 13 December 2016, a flashflood incident transpired at Brgys. Langkong and Buayan, M'lang, Cotabato brought about by heavy rains and local thunderstorm in the area.

B. Effects:

A total of 165 families were affected, broken down as follows:

Barangay	No. of Families Affected
Brgy. Langkong	45
Brgy. Buayam	120

- A total of 20 families from Brgy. Langkong temporarily evacuated in higher grounds and returned back to their respective homes after floodwaters subsided.
- The incident also resulted to damage in agriculture and properties.

C. Actions Taken:

- BDRRMCs Langkong and Buayan, and Local Search and Rescue Group conducted pre-emptive evacuation to the affected families.
- MDRRMO M'lang provided family food packs to the affected families.
- Local Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) Team is still conducting assessment and validation on the extent of damages in the area.
- MDRRMC M'lang conducted a meeting regarding the situation.
