1. Initial Report on the Paralytic Shellfish Poisoning in Cabucgayan, Biliran

A. Situation Overview:

- On December 22, 2016, DOH RO8 HEMO reported six (6) cases of paralytic shellfish poisoning from the Municipality of Cabucgayan, Biliran. Four (4) were admitted in Biliran Provincial Hospital, two (2) as out-patient. Of the four (4) admitted, one (1) patient died at around 9:20 PM of 21 December 2016.
- Per PIDSR 8 report, shellfish was bought from a vendor of Brgy. Gayad, Carigara, Leyte. Affected residents experienced nausea, vomiting, tingling sensation of lips and upper extremities and abdominal pain.

A. Situation Overview:

From December 16-19, 2016, rainfall updates and thunderstorm advisories were issued affecting Eastern Visayas.

the residents of Brgy Yakal, Catarman, Northern Samar who were severely affected by the flashfloods coming from the overflowing river near the barangay. The evacuees were brought to the evacuation center at Poblacion, Catarman, Northern Samar. Said activity ended at about 1:00 PM of the same day.

- Prepared relief goods for the evacuees in areas affected
- Dispatched RDANA Team

- Activated all communications group to conduct search and rescue operations on the missing fisherman

CDRRMO Borongan City

- CDRRMO and the City of Borongan Search and Rescue Team (COBSART) immediately responded to the landslide incident at Brgy. North Sabang
- Coordinated with PDRRMO and DPWH re clearing operations
- Facilitated the conduct of evacuation of the affected residents

- Distributed **650** family food packs to 1,004 families


