### **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 06 re Tropical Depression “AURING”**

#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**

**Tropical Depression “AURING” has maintained its strength as it continues to move closer over Surigao Del Sur.**

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within the 300 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.
- Residents of areas with TCWS No. 1 and over the rest of Davao Region and of Northern Mindanao are alerted against possible flash floods and landslides.
- Expected to make landfall over Surigao Del Sur between today (evening) until tomorrow (early morning).
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out over the eastern seaboard Visayas and of Mindanao.

<b>Location of Eye/Center</b>	At <b>7:00 AM</b> today, the center of Tropical Depression (TD) “AURING” was estimated based on all available data at <b>100 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (08.1°N, 127.2 °E)</b> .
<b>Strength</b>	Maximum sustained winds of up to <b>55 kph</b> near the center and gustiness of up to <b>70 kph</b> .
<b>Forecast Movement</b>	Forecast to move <b>West Northwest</b> at <b>7 kph</b>

#### ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 6 for Tropical Depression “AURING”** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
