I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

Tropical Depression "AURING" has maintained its course as it moves closer to Bohol.

- Estimated rainfall amount is from moderate to heavy within 300 km diameter of the Tropical Depression.
- Residents of areas with TCWS No. 1 and over the rest of Eastern and Central Visayas are alerted against possible flash floods and landslides.
- Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out over the eastern seaboard of Visayas and of Mindanao.

ACTIONS TAKEN

- NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Severe Weather Bulletin No. 12 for Tropical Depression "AURING"** to all OCD Regional Offices through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
- Directed RDRRMCs concerned through the OCD Regional Offices to undertake precautionary measures in their areas of responsibility (AOR) and subsequently advised local DRRMCs to initiate pre-emptive evacuation of families in low-lying areas and mountainous areas if situations warrants.
