PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **450 KM East of Surigao City, Surigao del Norte (9.0N, 129.5E)**. Tail-end of a cold front affecting the Eastern section of Southern Luzon. Northeast monsoon affecting Northern and Central Luzon.
