AVERAGE BASIN RAINFALL AS OF 7:00 AM TODAY:

Past 24-hrs observed rainfall = 2.6 MM

Forecast 24-hr basin rainfall = Light to Moderate Rains

WATERWAYS NO LONGER LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED:

- TRIBUTARIES OF UPPER AND MIDDLE MAIN AGNO RIVER;
 - Ambayaoan River
 - Viray-Depalo River
 - Banila and Totonogen Rivers
 - Streams
- LOWER AGNO RIVER AND ITS TRIBUTARIES;
 - Tarlac, Camiling, Bayaoas Rivers and Streams
- ALLIED RIVERS
 - PANTAL-SINOCALAN RIVER AND TRIBUTARIES Tuboy, Ingalera, Tagamusing Rivers and Streams
 - CAYANGA RIVER AND TRIBUTARIES- Bued-Patalan, Angalacan and Aloragat Rivers and Streams

Generally, water levels of some rivers within the basin are below alert stage. The residents and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction Management Councils (LDRRMC's) concerned are still advised to maintain precautionary measures to mitigate adverse impacts of river flooding.
