PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at the vicinity of Motong, Zamboanga Del Norte (7.5 N, 122.22 E). Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.

Lucia, Lugan, Malaybalay, Maapon, Bucal (Lalangan), Lakayat, Tignoan, Agos, Anibawan (Polilio Island) and Upper Kilbay-Catabangan RIZAL particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa BATANGAS particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kaumpong, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Lawaya) CAVITE particularly Laboc (Balsahan), Cañas, Ilang-Ilang and Imus LAGUNA particularly Pagsanjan, Pila-Sta. Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal
