PRESENT WEATHER:

At 3:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 985 KM East Northeast Guiuan, Eastern Samar (14.1°N, 134.2°E). Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) affecting Mindanao.
