WATERCOURSES LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 Rivers and Tributaries in: ILOCOS SUR particularly Lower Abra, Silay-Sta. Maria, and Buaya. LA UNION particularly Amburayan, Bararo, Lower Bauang and Aringay. ILOCOS NORTE particularly Bulu, Banban, Bacarra-Vintar, Laoag and Quiaoit. PANGASINAN particularly Balingcuguin and Alaminos.
