WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	Rivers and Tributaries in: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• MAGUINDANAO particularly Nituan, Mindanao, Dalika, Allah, Buluan, Mataber, Ylang, and Lower MLang.• LANA DEL SUR particularly Dapao and Mataling.• BASILAN particularly Gubauan and Gumalarang.• SULU rivers and its tributaries.



Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.
