**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **3:00 AM** today, the center of Tropical Depression "TINO" was estimated based on all available data at **305 KM West Northwest** of Puerto Princesa City, Palawan (**10.6N 116.1E**) with maximum sustained winds of up to **55 KM/H** and gustiness of up to **80KM/H**. It is forecast to move west northwest at **28 KM/H**. Northeast monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.
