PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 PM** today, the center of Tropical Storm "SALOME" (HAIKUI) was estimated based on all available data at **190 KM West Northwest of Iba, Zambales (15.9°N, 118.3°E)** with maximum sustained winds of **75 km/h** near the center and gustiness of up to **90 km/h**. It is forecasted to move **Northwest** at **20 KM/H**.
